1 Program Overview

Online Program (August 18-20):

- Welcome and orientation session
- Introductory lectures on leadership, Catholic Social Teaching, and the Economy of Francesco vision
- Virtual networking and preparation for workshops

In-Person Program (August 24-31):

- Daily keynote lectures by theologians, economists, and business leaders from Europe and the U.S.
- · Interactive workshops and group projects
- Daily Mass (optional but encouraged)
- Split city tour and cultural immersion
- Special daytrip to Međugorje on Wednesday, August 27
- Final presentations and reflection sessions

What to Bring

- Light clothing, suitable for summer but respectful and dignified
- Comfortable shoes for walking tours and hats (if needed)
- Refillable water bottle
